

Publishing Your Book

Let's make this short and simple:

1. Sign up or Log in to your kindle account:

2. It should automatically go to your bookshelf, click add title:



Enroll in KDP Select! It is vital in your success.

Introducing KDP Select - a new option to make money and promote your book. When you make your book exclusive to Kindle for at least 90 days, it will be part of the Kindle Owners' Lending Library for the same period and you will earn your share of a monthly fund when readers borrow your books from the library. You will also be able to promote your book as free for up to 5 days during these 90 days. Learn more

By checking the box, you are enrolling in KDP Select. Books enrolled in KDP Select must not be available in digital format on any other platform during their enrollment. - 3. Fill in your Book details upload your book file and book cover.
- Do not enable digital rights management <>< Select this option!</p>
- 4. Preview your book and if all looks good verify your territories
- 5. Now onto pricing. This can be the difference in you succeeding and

failing!

I am telling you to price your book \$2.99 to \$9.99 this is to receive 70% commission. If you sell a book for 99p you are not going to make the profits you want, especially at 35% commission!

If your book is <u>fiction</u> you can price your book higher anything from \$4-\$9.99

If your book is <u>Non-fiction</u> then from \$2.99 to \$7.99 I would go for lower than \$6 from personal experience.

If it is a <u>recipebook</u> then make it from \$3.50-\$9.99 depending on the amount of recipes. (a 100 recipe book can easily fetch \$7.99 with a good title and cover)

Tip. I wouldn't put my price at exactly \$2.99 because a lot of other people are, put it at an attention seeking number I always have it as .17 or .67 (habit) It sometimes makes them look twice at your book. So if it was a thrown together Recipe Book with only 30 recipes in it with a good cover and title, I would price it as \$3.67.

Clicks publish and now you just have to wait for approval from Amazon! If you have followed this guide there should be no reason for rejection!
